


# PEN SHAPED MOBILE PHONE **INSTRUCTION MANUAL**

## PRODUCT DESCRIPTION





#### **KEYPAD**



- A Previous
- B Play/ Pause
- C Next
- D Confirm (OK)/ Menu
- E Return/ Clear
- F Radio Manual tune (increase)/ Torch (long press)
- G Radio Manual tune (decrease)/ Camera (short press)
- H Pick up (answer)

- I Hang up / Home screen/ Turn off (long press)
- J Keypad
- K "1" = (long press) Activate Recording
- L "5" =Take photos/ videos
- M -Increase volume (MP3/Radio)
- N Decrease volume (MP3/Radio)
- O Turn on/ off Bluetooth on pen shaped mobile phone (long press - only works if Bluetooth is turned off on smartphone)

# **BATTERY CHARGING**

### Before first use, fully charge - CHARGING TIME FOR FULL CHARGE: About 2H


- 1. Use the included charging cable to connect the device to a USB port of a computer or any charging device.
- 2. After plugging in, the screen turns on and the battery icon showing the state of charging displays. A few seconds later, it turns off. Press any button to show the state of charging.
- 3. Unplug when finished charging.

Note: If the device has not been used for a long time, please fully recharge it before use.



# NANO SIM CARD AND TF CARD INSERTION


# NANO SIM CARD (not included)



Insert the tip of your finger into the notch to open the battery compartment.

Remove the cover.


Remove the battery which hides the SIM cards' slots.



Insert the tip of your finger into the hole of the metallic element. Push downward.

Lift up to open the metallic slot and move it down.

Insert the SIM card with the text facing up.




Put the metallic element back to its place.

Put your finger into the notch and push upward.

Place the battery back.

Align the camera lens on the pen with that of the cover.
Then, close the cover.

## TF card (not included - 32 GB max)



To operate the memory card, refer to "Menu" part, E. Multimedia

After installing the SIM card, insert TF card firmly into the metallic rectangle slot.

After insertion and after turning on the device, "Card plugged in" displays. Press to confirm.

## **OPERATION**

### 1. TURN ON/ TURN OFF

1. To turn on/ off, press and hold button till the screen turns on/ off.

#### 7. AUDIO PLAYER

Compatible audio format: MP3 and WAV

- 1. Press \* to enter audio player.
- 2. Press (left key) to enter "options". Choose "local list" (memory card or phone ) or "BT music" (you choose be connected via bluetooth) by pressing \*\*or \*.
- 3. Then press (left key) to confirm your choice.
- **4.** If you choose local list and if MP3 or WAV files are listed, Press ♠ or ➡ to select desired audio file. Press ◯ (left key) to play.
- 5. The audio player interface displays. Press button to play or pause. press → or → to play the previous/ next song,
- 6. Press \* or # to decrease or increase the volume.
- 7. If you choose « BT music », you should be successfully connected via bluetooth. Refer to part 6.Bluetooth above for connexion. Open music player on your smartphone and play the song which could be heard from the phone if you are on the audio interface (refer to step 1). To operate the audio player, refer to steps 4 and 5.

Note: The Bluetooth music player will occasionally stop playing the music after a long-time work.

#### 8. FLASHLIGHT

Press and hold for 2 seconds to turn on/turn off LED light.

### **MENU**

### A. ENTERING THE MENU

- 1. On the home screen, press (left key) to enter the menu.
- 2. Use \* or \* to toggle through the different menus: phonebook, call center (call records), messaging, multimedia, organizer, settings, services and BT dialer.
- 3. Stop pressing when you reach your desired option.
- 4. Press to confirm.

To operate the different menus and other options/ suboptions, use the keys below:

	Key	Action
	(left key)	Enter or confirm.
SS	▲ or ▼	Go through the list or select menu,option or sub-option.
PRES	Digit or letter keypad	To dial a number, input a message or input contact name/ phone number
	(right key)	Go back to the previous page or menu. To clear.

## **B. PHONE BOOK MENU**

- 1. After entering the menu and selecting phonebook menu, press \_\_\_\_\_:o confirm. The phone book list displays.
- 2. Use \* or \* to toggle through the list and select the desired contact.
- Press \_\_\_\_ to confirm and display the options.

4. Use ≜ or ▼to select desired option among the list : View, Send text, Call, Edit, Delete, Copy, Phonebook.

## Phonebook's options

- 1. **View** = You can see the name and phone of the contact selected. In the sub-options, you can edit, send text or call.
- 2. **Send text** = Use keypad to write the text. Press to enter the list of options : **« Send to»**, « Input method »: Select the format to write the text, « Insert template » : Select a message model, « Advanced » : Insert a number from phonebook and « Save ».
- 3. **Call**: Either choose local call (after confirming, you can call directly the number) or bluetooth call (you should be connected).
- 4. **Edit**: Modify, cancel or save the contact
- 5. **Delete**: Supress the contact from your phonebook.
- 6. Copy: Copy contact to phone, SIM or file.
- 7. Phonebook: Copy, move contact information or delete all contacts.

#### Add a contact

After entering the phone book menu, use a or to select "Add new contact" at the top of the list. Select to save either on "SIM" or "Phone". Then add name/ phone number and save.

#### C. CALL RECORDS

In this menu, you can view the recent phone call history or delete call records: missed, dialled, received, calls or view call log,

#### D. MESSAGING MENU

The options are below:

- Message: Write, select the writing input format and send.
- Inbox: View the list of received messages sent to SIM card, select the message, reply, save to SIM 1 or reply.
- Drafts: Write drafts, save, send, edit or delete.
- Outbox: Resend, edit or delete failed messages.
- Delete all messages in inbox, outbox or drafts

#### E. MULTIMEDIA

The options are below:

**1. File manager:** First select the phone or the memory card. After selecting the type of file (audio, photos, etc.) and confirming, select the options: Open, rename, delete photo/ music or video folder or create a new one.

For options 2, 4 and 5 below, make sure that you have enough memory on your pen phone otherwise these functions could not be operated. Insert a memory card with empty space or enough memory.

2.	Camera: Get access to camera to take picture. Press "5" to take photo.
	To enter the memory card, you should be on camera interface. Then, press (left key), to
	enter the options. Choose « 5.Storage », select TF card (second position on the list). press
	(left key) to confirm. Then take the photo by pressing « 5 ».

- 3. Image viewer: Press \* or \* to scroll through the pictures, select and confirm to view.
- 4. Video recorder: Before recording a video, choose the SD card as storage medium: enter multimedia menu, enter video recorder, press (left key) to enter the options. Choose and enter « 4.Storage », select TF card (second position on the list). press (left key) to confirm. Press « 5 » to start recording, press « 5 » again to pause/restart. Press (right key) to save.

- 5. Video player: Enter Video player Options. Choose the storage medium where the video was saved: Phone or TF card. Press (left key) to confirm. Press to play/ stop. Press and hold or ▶ to rewind or fast forward.
- 7. Sound recorder: Enter options'list, select « 1 :New record », press (left key) to pause or (right key) to save.
- 8. FM radio: Select option 3: "Auto search" to perform an auto scan. When the scan is finished, the displayed radio frequency is on. Then select option 1: "Channel list", then use of to select the scanned radio frequency. Then press (left key) twice to confirm. Note: The maximum allocated radio frequencies after scanning is 30 but it depends on the local available frequencies when you perform the scan.

  In option "2.Manual input", then "edit", clear the former radio frequency, input a new one manually. For example for 96.8, use the keypad and press to input the dot between "96" and "8". Then, save.

To operate the radio, press ■ to play/ stop the radio. Press ◀ or ▶▶ to listen to previous or next radio frequency available. Press ♠ or ➡ to manual tune.

#### F. ORGANIZER

- Magic voice: This function allows you to change your voice to sound like the one of a male, female or child during calls. Select « none » to keep your voice. Note: This function only works when the SIM card is inserted into the pen mobile phone. A call by bluetooth has no magic voice.
- Calendar: View the current date (only if the date is set refer to « 7. Settings » menu).
- Alarm: 5 alarms in total can be set. Use or to select desired position of alarm in the list. Input the alarm time and save. Then activate/ deactivate it, select alarm occurrence (once, everyday, etc.) and choose alarm tone on each alarm
- Incoming call flashlight: If this function is activated, the flashlight turns on when the phone is ringing.
- Torch : Turn on/ off.

### G. SETTINGS

- Profiles: General/ silent/ Meeting or Outdoor mode
- Phone settings: Time and date: Press a or to select. The item selected should be in blue. Input date and time. Then save. / language menu/ Input method for message/ Display (wall paper –auto lock screen Date and time display)/ Flight or normal mode/ « Misc. Setting »: Brightness = Use for to set backlight. Then confirm./ Picture quality = ON or OFF.
- Security settings: SiM security (Pin lock/ change pin)/ Phone lock or unlock/ Change password lock
- Connectivity: Bluetooth activation/ deactivation/ Visibility: ON/ OFF -the smartphone can be searched. only if it is disconnected)/ Bluetooth name: Mini BT pen (it can be modified)/ Anti lost settings (Activate ot to avoid the pen shaped phone to be lost. When it is over 10 meters far away from the paired device, it will ring.)
- Restore settings: enter default password: 1234 to restore the factory settings.


## H. SERVICES

This menu is only operational if your SIM card supports STK function.

#### I. BT DIALER

- Search new devices around. Activate Bluetooth function and pair with new Bluetooth device selected.
- 2. Select the name of Bluetooth device. You can either disconnect, delete or view help options.

# **REFILL CHANGE**



## **WARNINGS**

- 1. Keep away from sources of heat, direct sunlight, humidity, water or other liquids.
- 2. Do not operate it under high temperature.

- 10. To prevent possible hearing damage, do not listen at high volume levels for long periods.
- **11.** Do not use your mobile phone while driving.
- **12.** Switch off your mobile phone near medical apparatus.
- 13. At full volume, extended use of the mobile audio player could damage the user's ears

## SAFE INSTRUCTIONS FOR BATTERY

# **ATTENTION**

- Lithium-ion batteries can easily rupture, ignite, or explode when exposed to high temperatures, or direct sunlight.
